vagaries of our Town Traffic problems and will hopefully alleviate any future necessity to bring enforcement officers or traffic systems to the town and you can play your part in keeping enforcement free by observing the advisory markings at all times and especially in the area around Spar and Co-op. We should also be able to review the Neighbourhood Development Plan that a huge amount of work has gone into albeit that it has been delayed over 12 months due to Covid. We were also recently successful in being allocated a small grant to help tidy up the Town and this has been allocated to weed removal, moss removal and sign cleaning in and around the Town Centre.

Hopefully 2022 can be a year of progress and although no one knows what is around the corner I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your support over the last year and to wish you a very Happy Christmas and prosperous New Year.

Save the Stars - getting ready for the builders

Although there's not much to see when you pass by the former Stars Newsagent, a lot of activity is going on behind the scenes. Western Power have been and will be providing a new three phase supply. Work will take place early in the New Year, and involve laying the cable across Church Street, but every effort will be made to minimise the disruption.

Our architect is busy preparing the technical drawings, and he recently met on site with the structural engineer to discuss how best to extend the existing steel structure that supports the residential part of the building above the shop area. The Trust is in contact with local builders who may want to tender for the build and is keen to employ local traders wherever possible.

To help finance the work, in addition to our own fundraising efforts , the Trust will be securing a mortgage from the Ecology Building Society and is in early discussion with the Lottery over possible funding for the non-residential part of the project. We have already raised over £5,000 from the local community, and hope to meet our target of £30,000.

Auction Yard Toilets

The Toilets in the Auction Yard were transferred from Shropshire Council to the Town Council in April 2011 with a one off grant to assist with maintenance and upkeep. However some 10 years later the infrastructure and condition of the facility has deteriorated somewhat. Parts for the automated systems are becoming more expensive and harder to source since the company that installed them ceased trading.

With the above in mind we are exploring grant or loan funding to provide a refit and refurbishment of them but in order to secure this we have to provide examples of consultation with the public to gauge the depth of feeling for this commitment.
